

RELEASE INFORMATION: Digital recording techniques and the Internet have drastically changed the music business. This also goes for unauthorized recordings. Nowadays almost every Rolling Stones show is being circulated in digital form within 36 hours among collectors (this also goes for all shows form this tour), often in pre-prepared CD format with appealing artwork. This change has led to an almost complete disappearance of the "classical" CD bootleg market. – It is, of course, impossible to keep track of the growing number of releases coming out of the "no label" digital camp. From 2013 onwards "The Ultimate Guide" therefore only lists performances/ recordings but no more BT CDs or unauthorized digital releases.
